

Project Updates

The 4th Transnational project meeting that was support to be host in Norway by TERRAMPACIS from 1st- 4th April 2020 was move to online because the inability of partners to travel and meet physically, for this reason the meeting was hosted on the Gotomeet online platform and recorded on 01/04/2020.

The topics discussed during the meeting were the following: Implementation of the project activities, next steps, analysis and feedback on the work already done, implementation of the short term joint staff training activity C1.

The manual is ready and translated and will be fine-tuned by VHS SOB that will prepare an example of the printed manual, in English in the formats A4.

The short term joint staff training event has been postponed to the first suitable date in 2021. All the partners are currently working on the materials for the short term staff training, if the COVID allowed.



Short term joint staff training event

The short term joint staff training event will last 5 days and will take place in Kalamata, Greece.

3 staff members from each partner (Spain, Germany, Italy, Greece, Hungary, Norwey, Slovenia) will attend (21 in total).

The training course gives the opportunity to provide skills and. theoretical-practical ITC skills (about social network in the work field) for adult, test the materials developed to date, create videos, to be uploaded to the Web Platform.

Digital education during the pandemic

The COVID-19 crisis has resulted in a significant increase in online learning by adults. Much of the training that had started as face-toface in classroom environments has been pursued online. As such, the crisis provides a powerful test of the potential of learning online. It also highlights its key limitations, including the prerequisite of adequate digital skills, computer equipment and internet access to undertake training online, the difficulty of delivering traditional work-based learning online, and the struggle of teachers used to classroom instruction.
