




HOW ARE THE COURSES STRUCTURED?



Courses start from the simplest action of turning on and shutting down a computer, and after develop in several more advanced steps.

Practical lessons consist of quizzes, oral questions and / or exercises.






ADVANCED COURSES

NONNO INFLUENCER COURSE



association website.







During the lockdown period many people, especially those living by themselves, due to isolation, found themselves in need to be connected with other people by reaching associative and digital networks.

Given that all in presence activities were reduced or suspended, it became necessary to switch to online activities.









A TOOL CALLED STREAMYARD


This amazing tool, also available in a free version, offers the opportunity to have up to a maximum of six speakers simultaneusly connected online.




How it works:

The procedure is very simple: the organizer logs in to Streamyard and indicates on which Facebook group or page the live session should take place; the organizers copies and forwards the link to the others speakers, they must click on the link and activate the audio and webcam, at this point they enter a "virtual room".









This course deals with different topics such as current topics related to the pandemic, information topics like where to find images for free and useful day-to-day life insights like how to create a Paypal account to but things online.

WEAKNESSES




Accessing this course requires an ICT basic level, in fact, those who participate in the online smartphone course where mainly people who attended classroom lessons.


